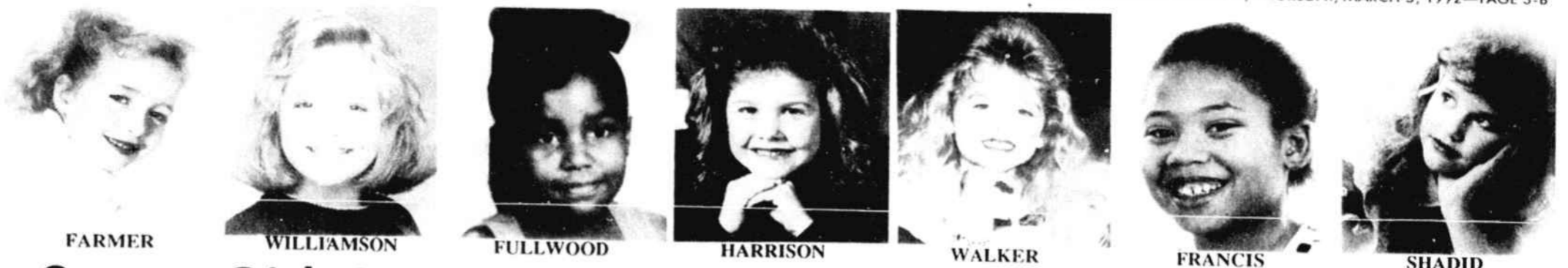
Club Donates
