Three Men Fined \$200 Each For Taking Rare Venus's Flytraps

Three men charged with taking Venus's flytraps, a rare and protected plant, from the grounds of Orton Plantation pleaded guilty in Brunswick County District Court last week

N.C. Wildlife Enforcement Officer Milton McLean charged the men on Jan. 26 with taking protected plants from the lands of another without permission and taking protected plants without a collecting li-

Pleading guilty to the charges last Wednesday, March 11, were Archie Lee Williams, 41, of Route 1, Bolivia; William Henry Daniels, 29, of Route 2, Supply; and Michael Anthony Williams, 29, of Route 1,

After consolidating the charges, Judge Napoleon B. "Poli" Barefoot Jr. fined each defendant \$200 and ordered that they not go back about the premises of Orton Plantation, which is located on N.C. 133 south of Belville.

Venus's flytraps are rare, insecteating plants with leaves that form an insect trap. North Carolina laws protect them for they are only found in the Green Swamp and other wetlands within a 75-mile radius of

In the spring, the plants produce a rising stem of blossoms that makes them easier for poachers to spot. Plants retail at garden shops for around \$6 each.

Illegal poaching has threatened the species and has led to stricter penaltics for stealing them from private property or protected areas. The minimum fine is \$100 for a first offense and \$500 for a second offense while the maximum penalty is a \$1,000 fine in either case.
