Service through the Social Security Administration's 800 number system is available from 7 a.m. till 7 p.m. each weekday by calling 1-800-772-1213.

Since the service was made available nationwide two years ago, it has proven to be extremely popular, as callers find most matters can be handled to completion during the initial call.

For anyone in Brunswick County

who needs to change a mailing address, report a missing check, request a benefit estimate, set up an appointment to file a claim, or simply ask a question, help is just a phone call away.

Although service at this 800 number is available 12 hours daily, the busiest times are from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. The best times to call are early call.
