Shellfish Relayed In Shallotte River

Three sections of Shallotte River were closed to shellfishing this week to allow the relay of oysters from polluted to clean waters.

The waters near Carter's Fish and Oyster House and Milliken's Oyster House were closed Monday to allow the relay.

Fishermen are paid S1 per bushel to move the oysters, which will cleanse themselves and be ready for harvest in the fall.

The N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries closed the local waters and is supervising the oyster relay.


