

Search On For Missing Leland Man

Brunswick County sheriff's detectives are searching for a Leland man who wandered from a boarding house and was reported missing Friday.

Joseph Richard Carroll, 61, wandered away from the Thomas and McKoy Nursing Home near Belville, said Sheriff's Lt. Donnell Marlowe.

The white male was last seen wearing a checkered shirt, brown pants, black shoes, white socks and a checkered coat. He also wears black-framed glasses.

He has black hair, stands about 5 feet 9 inches tall and weighs around 187 pounds.

Carroll walked from the nursing home around 9:30 a.m. Friday en route to the Scotchman store in Belville and hasn't been seen since, said Marlowe. He is disabled and has no sense of direction, but should have the name and address of the nursing home in his possession.

Carroll has wandered away before but was later found. He was a boarder at the home on Blackwell Road, Leland.

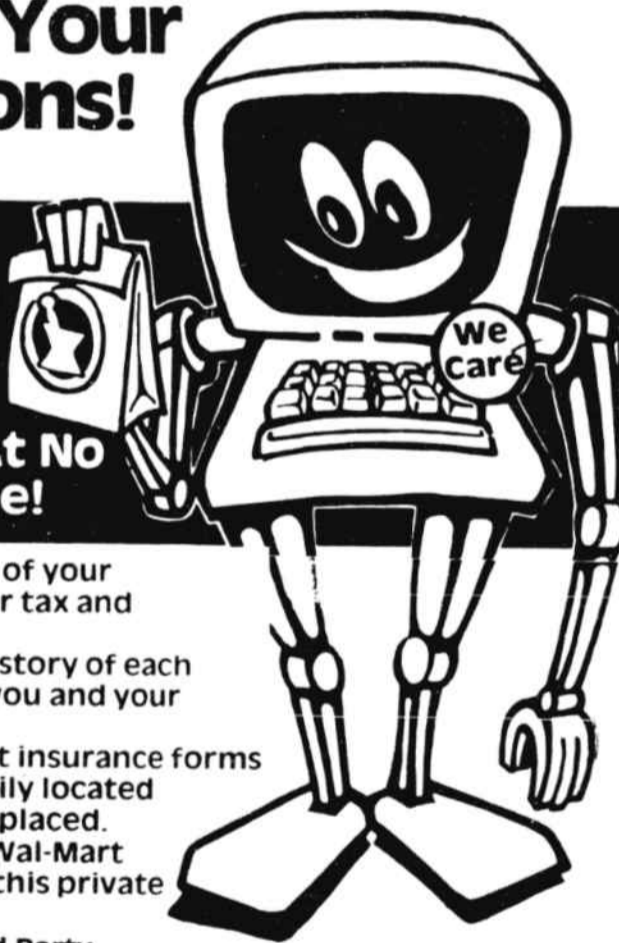
