Area residents donated another \$1,242 to the Chris Caudill bone marrow transplant fund Sunday as the Brunswick County Cloggers entertained at the Varnamtown landing. "Everybody really enjoyed it," spokesperson Marlene Varnam said. "It was a good turnout and good entertainment."

Mrs. Varnam said the fund drive has raised about \$30,000. The money is being raised to help Chris Caudill of Supply, a 36-year-old mother of two boys who needs a costly bone marrow transplant.

Mrs. Caudill went to Duke University Hospital this week to see if she needs any more chemotherapy treatment before a transplant, Mrs. Varnam said.

Several events are planned in May to raise more money to help cover medical expenses.

The Coates Family of Conway, S.C., will perform at a special gospel sing at Dixon Chapel United Methodist Church in Varnamtown on Sunday, May 3, at 7 p.m. A love offering will be taken during the sing.

Dixon Chapel also will sponsor a ham dinner on Wednesday, May 6, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

On May 11, Burger King of Shallotte will host a fund-raiser and donate 20 percent of its sales from 5

p.m. to 8 p.m. to the Caudill fund.

Dixon Chapel will host a fish fry and auction Saturday, May 23. Fish will be served from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., when the auction will begin.

Items to be auctioned off include cakes, pies, a coffee grinder, exercise machine, patchwork quilt, oak quilt rack and a framed print of the old ferry at Holden Beach.

Tri-Beach Volunteer Fire Department near Holden Beach will conduct a fund-raising auction Saturday, May 2, beginning at 7 p.m.


The auction will be held at the fire department building on Sabbath Home Church Road just east of the Holden Beach Causeway.
