Toni Holden of Wilmington was pianist. Dianne Holden attended the guest book and Terri Durham attended the programs. Alice Robbins directed the wedding.

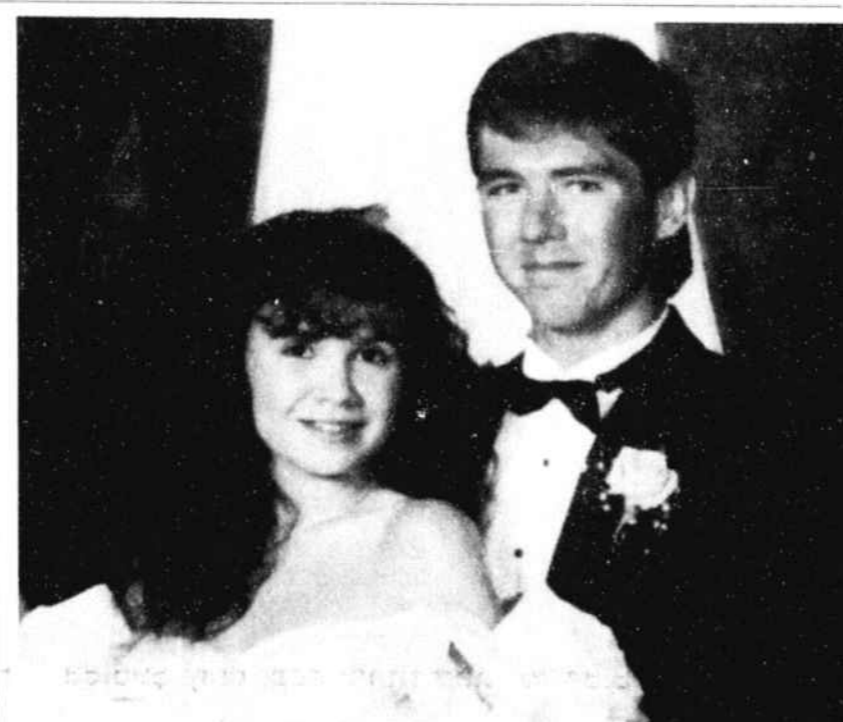
The groom's parents gave a rehearsal buffet dinner at their home in Shallotte for members of the wedding party and close friends.
