
DIETS DON'T WORK!




Disability leave was granted to Supply Elementary teacher Annie B. Hewett and Supply Elementary teacher assistant Nancy Vereen, subject to state approval.

Todd is a retired district manager for Ohio Bell Telephone and was mayor of an Ohio town which bought a water plant with Farmers


