Calabash Man Gets 8 Years For Break-In, Forgeries

A 36-year-old Calabash man was laws for five years, not assault, hasentenced to eight years in prison last week after pleading guilty in Brunswick County District Court to one charge of breaking and entering and three counts of common law

Dennis Gwendell Hines of Marlowtown Road was charged with six counts of felony forgery and one count of felonious breaking and entering. He agreed to plead guilty to four misdemeanor charges as part of a plea bargain in which two of the forgery charges were voluntarily dismissed.

Judge Jerry Jolly gave Hines four consecutive two-year sentences. He was given credit for 83 days he spent in jail awaiting trial.

In three days of district court action last week, Jolly presided Tuesday and Wednesday, while Judge David Wall heard cases Monday.
