All bids and proposals shall be for furnishing apparatus, supplies, materials, equipment and/or work and services in accordance with the applicable plans and specifications prescribed by the County Planner. From the date shown above until the date of opening the proposals, the plans and specifications of the proposed work and/or a complete description of the apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment and/or work and services are and will continue to be on file in the office of the County Planner at the Courthouse Building, Pamlico County, North Carolina, during usual office hours, and available to prospective bidders.

No proposal will be considered or accepted unless at the time of its filing the same shall be accompanied by a deposit in cash or a certified check

on some bank or trust company insured by The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the proposal. In lieu of making the cash deposit as above provided, such bidder may file a bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, all bid bonds, and deposits being further conditioned under G.S. 143-129, as amended.

The owner reserves the right to evaluate all bids especially where there is a wide range in specifications or to reject any and all bids and proposals, and further specifically reserves the right to make the award in the best interest of Pamlico County. Unless otherwise specified by the bidder, the owner reserves the right to accept any item in the bid.

In case of default of the contractor, Pamlico County, may procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.

No bid may be withdrawn once received by the Board of Commissioners of Pamlico County, and shall be binding upon the bidder for a period of ninety (90) days thereafter, unless the provisions of General Statutes 143-129 apply.
