700 pounds of 10-0-10 when the corn was knee high. Half of the area was planted to N. C. T-11 and the remainder in an average open pollinated corn. The hybrid produced 67.4 bushels per acre and the open pollinated corn yielded 44.6 bushels, according to Hendrix.

On an adjoining plot the fertilization was 200 pounds of 4-8-4 and 200 pounds of nitrate of soda. Under these conditions the T-11 hybrid produced 48 bushels and the open pollinated corn yielded only 21.8 bushels. Both areas were planted at the same time and cultivated in the same manner, Hendrix says.




