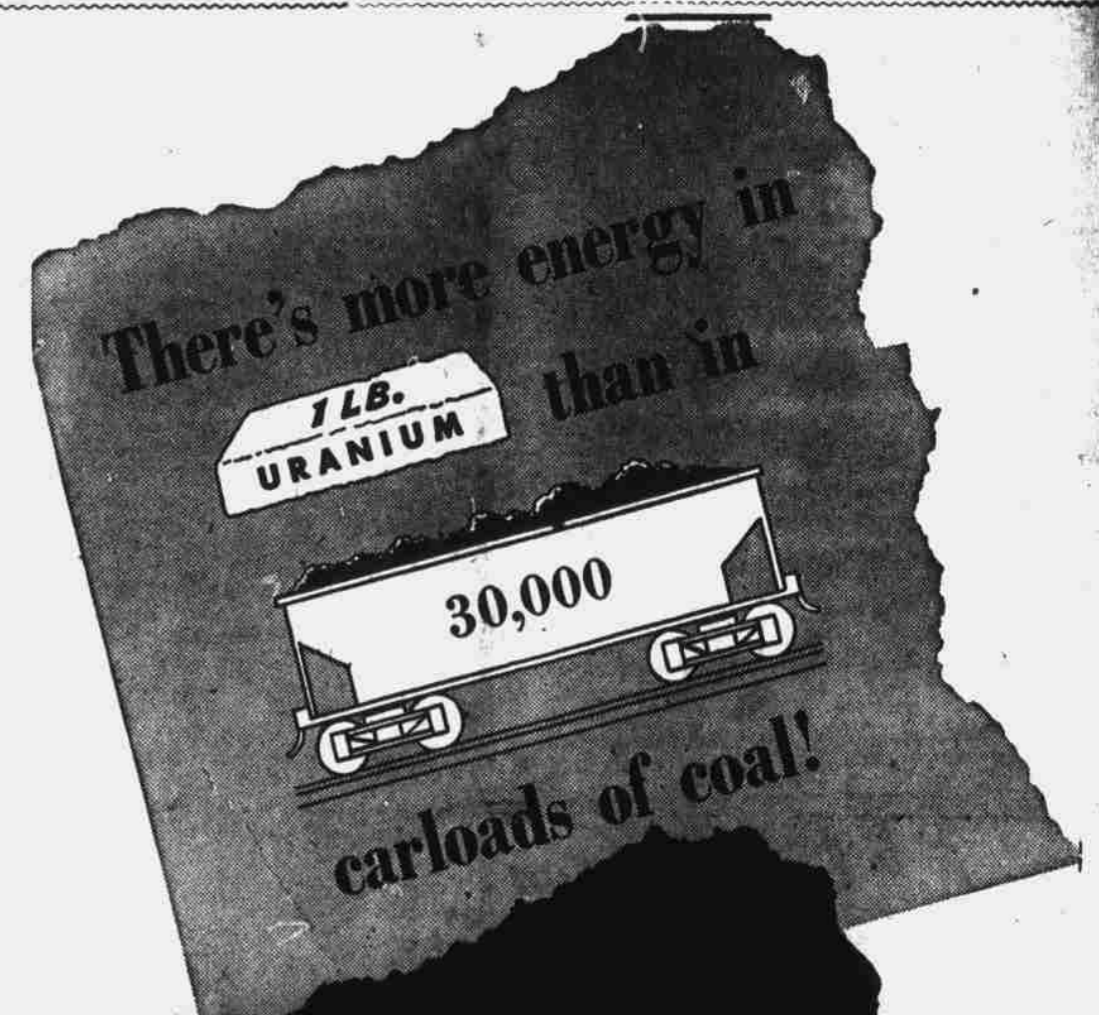

Prepare your lists now, and save time in listing, also avoid PENALTY for being delinquent after January 31st, 1946. This is required by the State Law. See Chapter 310, H. B. 46, Public Laws of North Carolina, Session 1939.
