

# Electrical Contest Open To 4-H Clubs

Final plans for the participation of 4-H Club boys and girls of Perquimans County in a Better Methods Electric Contest were made here Tuesday at a meeting of I. C. Yagel, county farm agent; Miss Frances Maness, W. J. Ridout, Jr., agricultural engineer of the North Carolina Extension Service and director of the contest; P. G. Morriette, representing the Virginia Electric & Power Company and other members of the county agent's staff.

Boys and girls entering the contest, now under way, must make a detailed study of a farm chore and make a report and recommendation on how this chore can be simplified by the use of electricity. The contest is designed to stimulate the use of more modern farm methods for better production at less cost in time and effort.

Participating in this territorial contest are 16 North Carolina counties. Two winners—one boy and one girl—will be chosen from each of the 16 counties to attend a 4-H Club Electric Congress scheduled to be held at N. C. State College in October. This Con-

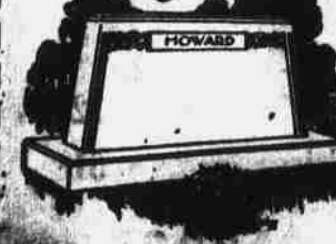

gress will climax the territorial contest. One winner from each county also will receive from the Westinghouse Educational Foundation a gold-filled medal of honor. The Virginia Electric and Power Company will award two first prizes of \$100 scholarships to the boy and girl winning in the Electric Congress in Raleigh. Two second prizes of engraved gold watches also will be awarded by the Virginia Electric & Power Company at the Congress.

Winners at the Electric Congress will be eligible to compete with other winners in the State for an all-expense trip to the National 4-H Club Congress to be held in Chicago in December.

County Agent I. C. Yagel is in charge of the contest in this county. He expressed the hope that all Perquimans County 4-H Club boys and girls will participate. Details of the contest will be presented to 4-H Club members at meetings this month, he said.

## Farmer Steals March With Early Peppers

J. O. Johnson of Benson, Route 2, one of the largest growers in the rapidly expanding sweet potato enterprise of the Meadow section of Johnston County, gives credit for his success to the fact that he always grows his plants in southern areas, according to John E. Pilant, assistant farm agent for the State College Extension Service.

Mr. Johnson has worked out an arrangement with some Florida farmers that goes something like this:

Sweet peppers are seeded early in special beds on these Florida farms. The plants are shipped to Mr. Johnson here in North Carolina when they are ready.

With the advantage gained by early seeding, Mr. Johnson gets his peppers in the field earlier than would be possible if the seed were bedded locally.

The result? He is usually one of the first in his section to have sweet peppers ready for market. The demand is strong and the best prices are in effect.

Always trying to improve the product he sells, Mr. Johnson is now at work on new varieties to determine which one is best suited for his market and farming conditions.

## State Cotton Contest Offers \$3,000 In Cash

North Carolina cotton farmers will compete for \$3,000 in state and district prizes, in addition to special county awards, in the 1947 Five-Acre Cotton Production and Quality Contest, it was announced yesterday by J. A. Shanklin, Cotton specialist for the State College Extension Service.

A special feature of this year's contest will be a prize of \$50 for the best contestant in counties where ten or more growers carry out all of the contest requirements, Shanklin said. State prizes of \$800 and \$400, and district prizes of \$300, \$200 and \$100 in each of the three districts, will also be offered. No farmer is eligible to receive more than one award.

Shanklin said the regulations this year will be practically the same as last year, emphasizing that all Five-Acre Contest plots must be selected by the farmer and identified by having corner markings before his plot is checked by the county agent.

As last year, the closing date for entries is July 1, and sponsors will be the State College Extension Service, co-operating with the N. C. Cotton Seed Crushers and Ginners, and the N. C. Cotton Growers Cooperative Association.

Any farmer who, in any previous state Five-Acre Cotton Contest, has won a prize is ineligible for the same prize, but he can compete for a different prize. Any farmer, landlord, and/or tenant producing as much as five acres of cotton in one body may compete, Shanklin said.
