

Many Tyrrell Farmers Entering Corn Contest

Tyrrell County farmers are showing a great deal of interest in a 1943 corn growing contest being sponsored by the Columbia Rotary Club, reports H. H. Harris, county agent, and M. P. Chestnutt, assistant agent for the State College Extension Service.

A total of 177 farmers entered the contest and have been personally visited by the agents to date.

Purposes of the contest are to raise the average county corn yield to 45 bushels per acre and to determine whether 75 to 100 bushels per acre can be produced economically.

Tyrrell business firms are cooperating with the Rotary Club in donating the following five top prizes which will be awarded on the basis of yields: First, medal and \$100 savings bond; second, \$75 worth of house paint and oil; third, one ton of fertilizer; fourth, \$25 worth of lumber; fifth, half a ton of 7-7-7 fertilizer.

At least one acre of corn must be grown. It is recommended that one acre of hybrid and one acre of field corn be planted side by side in the same square and treated alike, to give a check on the value of hybrids on the individual farm.

The county agent or assistant agent will visit each demonstration and

measure off the plots during the summer or early fall. Each farmer should gather the corn from the measured plots between September 25 and October 20.

All farmers entering the contest and producing more than 50 bushels per acre will be entertained by the Rotary Club at a supper sometime during the winter.

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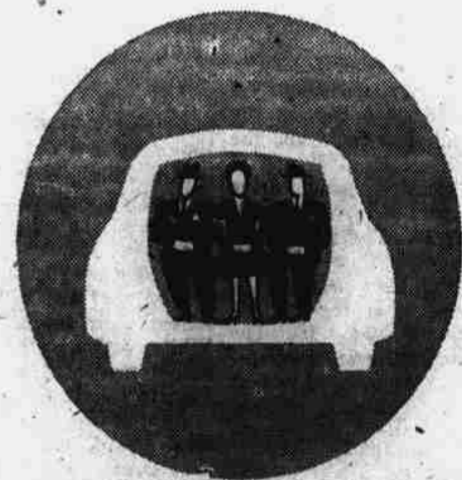
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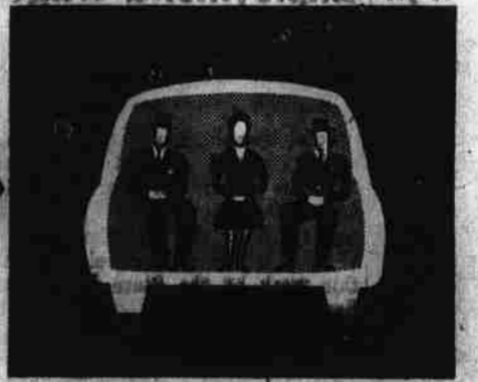
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
