

A Road Hazard

Perquimans County had its first highway death of the year last week when a young Kinston man lost his life as a result of an accident which occurred on the narrow strip of roadway which links Hertford with Route 17 beyond the by-pass to Winfall. This narrow roadway, known to residents of this community as the Causeway, is fast becoming a road hazard.

With the increase in passenger and truck traffic of the past year more and more accidents are occurring in this county because of the condition of Route 17 at this point. A specialist in Soviet economics reports that individual real wages in Russia declined about fifty per cant in the twenty years between 1928 and 1948.
