

## Dr. B. B. McGuire Extends Thanks For X-ray Cooperation

Dr. B. B. McGuire, district health officer, stated this week that the District Health Department desires to publicly thank the many organizations for their fine work in promoting the mass chest X-ray survey recently held. "Without the funds and full cooperation from the Pasquotank Tuberculosis and Health Association, the Chowan Tuberculosis Association and the Tuberculosis Seal Sales Committees in Perquimans and Camden counties," said Dr. McGuire, "the survey could not have been made."

Dr. McGuire extends special thanks to college and school officials and to the Edenton, Perquimans and Elizabeth City High School Bands for their nice parades. "High school principals and county superintendents were most cooperative in having the high school students X-rayed," said Dr. McGuire "and particular note is made of the cooperation of the churches, ministers and Sunday School superintendents for urging people to be X-rayed. Various Chambers of Commerce and civic organizations in all four counties were most helpful, as well as Boy and Girl Scouts."

The medical profession was especially in the front line. The physicians who permitted the use of their names in the letter to all the people are indeed to be commended. In rural areas, the services of the home demonstration clubs were most effective. The electric power companies were most cooperative in making power connections. The R. E. A. placed an announcement concerning the survey in their bulletin sent to all subscribers.

All individuals who served on committees in the survey were especially helpful. Without the newspaper and radio publicity, the survey would have at least bordered on failure. The Daily Advance, The Independent, The Chowan Herald and the Perquimans Weekly were most cooperative. Radio Station WCNC and WGAI were both cooperative and effective."
