### **State Cotton Growers** Warned To Save Seed

J. A. Shanklin, cotton specialist for the State College Extension Service, warns cotton growers in North Carolina to make provisions for saving their own seed from the 1950 crop or face a critical shortage of seed next spring.

The seed shortage extends throughout the Cotton Belt, according to Shanklin, and will prevent areas which formerly supplied surplus seed

from doing so next spring.

The State College specialist further estimates that about one-fourth of all the seed produced in the State this year will be needed to plant next

year's crop.

Not much more than 5 per cent of the seed produced is ordinarily needed for the next year's crop in North Carolina. However, the State is producing only 560,000 acres of co this year, as compared with a goal of


