

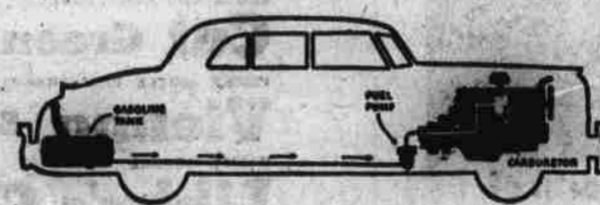

An Open Letter To Tractor Farmers

GENTLEMEN:

First, we very sincerely say that we greatly appreciate the privilege of serving you with your requirements of gasoline, kerosene, motor oils and greases as you find need for these items, and in appreciation of this privilege, we have set up for your convenience systems that we feel are a definite help in obtaining your five cents per gallon refund for gasoline used in non-highway equipment. The North Carolina Department of Revenue definitely states, "Delivery tickets or invoices must carry a statement made by the seller THAT THE TAX REFUND WILL BE REQUESTED. THEY MUST BE MARKED PAID BY THE SELLER and MUST NOT SHOW ANY ALTERATIONS OR ERASURES."

A small percentage of you gentlemen from time to time become delinquent in the payment of the deliveries of these petroleum products, and we are sure that it has never crossed your mind that we are not only sellers of these products, but have automatically and without choice become tax collectors for the State and Federal Governments and that these taxes must be remitted without fail, and to properly comply with these requirements WE MUST COLLECT FOR DELIVERING within a very reasonable length of time.

We ask that you be careful in determining those amounts used in non-highway equipment, and bear in mind that we are always anxious to serve you in any manner possible, but in order to serve you best, we must have your cooperation in these matters.

We are about at the starting point of another crop year, and may we say that we wish for you the best of weather conditions for the economical crop and prices satisfactory to all.
