Too Much Attention

Let's go back a week or so. Has the reader forgotten the dire pro-phecies of what the Russians would do to the San Francisco Conference which met to sign the treaty negotiated with Japan?

Of course, none of the predictions came about. All that Soviet Deputy Foreign Minister Gromyko could do was to talk and, after all, talk is not

always a dangerous weapon. The treaty proceedings came off on schedule, without any sensational event. All of which makes the various predictions look rather foolish and adds to the suspicion that the news-paper and radio people give entirely too much attention to the Russians.

"Bloodiest and Heaviest"

Governor Thomas E. Dewey, after an extended trip throughout the Pa-cific, including Korea, comes back to report that, in the Eighth Army, "we have the greatest fighting group in the world today."

Mr. Dewey says our troops are "battle-hard and battle-wise" and that they are, "beating the guerrillas at their own game."

Passing on to the general results of the fighting in that area, the Governor of New York declares that "the North Koreans and the Chinese Com-munists have taken the bloodiest and heaviest mass defeat in the history of the world."
