

Proceedings Of Commissioners

June 2, 1952.

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Perquimans County held on the first Monday, the 2nd day of June, 1952: Present and presiding A. T. Lane, Chairman, with Commissioners R. S. Chappell, E. A. Turner, Wm. C. Chappell, E. B. Hollowell. Absent none.

On motion, the commissioners approved the budget of \$1760 for year of 1952-53 as presented by J. W. Nowell, Forest Fire Warden of Perquimans County, for control of Forest Fires.

On motion the commissioners approved request that the State Highway and Public Works Commission make addition to highway system, take over and keep in a passable condition that certain road, lane, leading from Harvey Point Road to Perquimans Beach.

On motion, ordered that the Colored Cooperative Extension Personnel be granted a raise in salary as follows: Farm Agent, \$10.00 per month; home agent, \$10.00 per month; secretary, \$5.00 per month, beginning July 1, 1952.

On motion ordered, that county change order in Perquimans County Colored School in the amount agreed to by Perquimans County Board of Education.

On motion ordered, that in compli-

ance with the laws of the State of North Carolina which designated that all real property on which taxes are due for the current year be sold on the first Monday in May or any of the four successive months thereafter, the County Commissioners hereby order that the Sheriff of Perquimans County be and he is hereby directed to advertise said lands for sale on July 1, 1952 and to sell such lands or real estate on the first Monday in August, 1952.

It is further ordered that the Sheriff of Perquimans County be directed and he is hereby instructed and directed to levy on all personal property on which taxes are due the county of Perquimans.

ON MOTION ORDERED:
That all carnivals or shows of like kind are prohibited from showing

in Perquimans County and no license shall be issued by the Sheriff of Perquimans County to any such carnival or show of like kind unless said carnival or show of like kind is sponsored by a civic organization of said county and application for license has been approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Perquimans County, at a regular meeting of said Board.

The Commissioners adopted the Welfare Budget for the year 1952-53 which is attached hereto.
