Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Commissioners of Perquimans County, Hertford, North Carolina, in the Court Room, Perquimans County Court House, Hertford, North Carolina, until 11:00 A. M., E.S.T., September 18, 1953, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the construction of the Perquimans County Health Center, including walks, equipment and appurtenances thereto. Bids received after the hour named will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received for General Contract, Electrical, Plumbing and Heating.

Complete plans, specifications and contract documents will be open for inspection in the County Register of Deeds Office, Hertford, North Carolina, A. G. C. offices, Dodge Plan Rooms, and in the office of Wm. Moore Weber, A. I. A., Architect, 1918 Hillsboro Street, Raleigh, North Carolina. Prime contractors may obtain plans, specifications and other contract documents upon deposit of \$35.00 in cash or check. The full deposit will be returned to those submitting a bona fide proposal, provided plans and Architect in good condition, within five days after the date set for receiving bids. Sub-contractors and material dealers may purchase plans and specifications from the Architect for \$20.00 a set. Prime contractors may obtain additional plans and specifications for \$20.00 a set, prior to bid specifications are returned to the

opening. All contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State Laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by bid guarantee of 5% of the bid. Bid guarantee may be in cash or certified check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. In lieu of making the cash deposit as above provided, such bidder may file a bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bond, conditioned that the surety will upon demand forthwith make payment to the obligee upon said bond if the bidder fails to execute the contract in accordance with the bid bond and upon failure to forthwith make payment the surety shall pay to the obligee an amount equal to double the amount of said bond bid. This deposit shall be retained if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract within ten days

Performance bond will be required in amount of one hundred per cent (100%) to the contract price. Payment bond will be required in amount of fifty per cent (50%) of the contract price. Payment will be made on the basis of ninety per cent (90%) of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty days. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

NANCY CARTER Tested RECIPES

WESTERN RANCH MEAT LOAF
(A Meat Loaf With a Layer of Dressing in the Center)

2 pounds ground beef
1 onion, chopped
1 cup sliced celery
1 cup fat
1 cup chopped green pepper
1 tablespoon salt
2 Fick of the Neck eggs
2 cups soft bread crumbs
1 cup water
1 cup Ch tomato juice
2 tablespoons No Treat Margarine.

Brown onion and celery in the hot fat in a heavy skillet. Combine these with next five ingredients to make a stuffing. Add half of stuffing (1 1/2 cups) to the meat, mixing well. Pat out half the meat mixture into a greased 2-quart loaf pan. Cover meat with remaining stuffing, then top with remaining meat. Bake in moderate oven, 350 degrees, 1 1/2 hours. Combine tomato juice and melted margarine. After loaf has cooked 15 minutes, pour half of mixture over the meat. In about 15 minutes, pour over remainder of sauce. This adds flavor and keeps meat moist. Makes 10 to 12 servings.
