North Carolina institutions of high-learning will graduate next month is persons who plan to teach in the hite elementary schools of the State. ased on the demand for the current Rased on the demand for the current year, however, there is a need for 1,707 teachers in this field. Thus there will be more than 1,000 fewer properly trained teachers for the elementary schools for white children of the State than will be available.
