**World Communism's Goal**

Orders apparently went out from Moscow to all Communist parties of the world to do everything possible to wreck the proposed Western alliance in Southeast Asia. Also, a major goal of the Communists now is frustration of the U. S. effort to slowly rebuild and rearm Japanese defense forces.

The Communists seem to be concentrating now on wrecking a plan for setting up a NATO-type agreement in Asia, such as that which is functioning in Europe. It is widely accepted that the creation of NATO, and U. S. atom bombs, are the only reasons the Communists did not attempt to overrun more of Western Europe than they did.

The emergence of Red China in Asia as a new Communist aggressive power makes imperative some sort of Western alliance in that part of the world, and the Communists are this time trying to disrupt plans for such an alliance.

The Communists have just enjoyed a partial success in Europe, where they helped influence the French in the French rejection of the European Defense Treaty. Although Europe still has NATO, an alliance between fourteen nations to fight if any one is attacked, the Far East had no such alliance, and it was highly important for some sort of defensive alliance to be arranged.

That explains the urgency and determination of Secretary of State Dulles in Manila. It explained the

importance which the U. S. attached to the proposal for a Southeast Asia Treaty Organization—which is to be known as SEATO.

**School Days—School Problems**

An article in a recent issue of the Saturday Evening Post, outlining some of the problems which face school superintendents, points out, to the surprise of those who have given the subject little thought, the unlimited number of problems which today face school superintendents. The job of school superintendents is not one in which school administrators get rich, and the problems encountered sometimes drive superintendents out of the profession altogether.

Everyone knows that superintendents face various demands from various groups, but few people consider how frequent and diverse these demands can sometimes be.

Everyone wants a sensible and practical athletic program in the community schools, although intramural sports are often not stressed enough, and insufficient effort is made to get all students to participate in sports. Those who do not participate, and the under-sized, are the very ones who need the athletic program, not those who are already proficient in some sport.

In recent years sports events in the schools have grown to a major business scale and even in the lower elementary schools, competition is so keen for honors that junior is often forced to overextend himself to try to win a contest for his Alma Mater. A group studying this situation in the fourth, fifth and sixth grades recently found that children were often caused to exert themselves "beyond the point of healthful fatigue" in an effort to win some relatively unimportant contest.

It takes a brave school administrator to buck such a program, which is almost always a popular one.

The administrator is also beset by the necessity of setting an example in his community, by his task of representing the school board's views to the teachers and the opposite-interest responsibility of presenting the teachers' viewpoint to the board. All in all, then, the school superintendent is faced with a job which few of us fully appreciate.

Not the least among the other worries are his efforts to gain sufficient funds to carry on a modern school

program, his task of pleasing those who want more emphasis on the three R's and—on the other hand—those who want more emphasis on modern educational theories, and his delicate task of appointing teachers without offending politicians, powerful community leaders and others.

These things are problems every citizen should think about when he feels inclined to criticize the school system, or give the superintendent a piece of his mind. It might be well to remember that the superintendent has enough difficulties of his own, without any unnecessary contributions.
