

North Carolinians will vote November 2 on five proposed amendments to the State Constitution.

The first one would authorize the General Assembly to provide for recalling retired supreme court justices to fill temporary vacancies caused by illness or other emergencies. illness or other emergencies.

The second would authorize the General Assembly to create a board of paroles and confer upon it the authority to grant, revoke and terminate paroles which it now eexrcises by the

The third would limit to one, the number of State Senators from any one county.

The fourth would reduce from fou months to 30 days, the time a voter must reside in a precinct before becoming eligible to vote.

The fifth would permit the Gov-

ernor, in filling a vacancy in the executive or judicial departments, to executive or judicial departments, to appoint a person to serve the balance of the unexpired term if that term is to expire on the first day of January after the next general election.
