

**ACP Cites Pasture Improvements Need**

"A penny saved is a penny earned." That old adage has a special meaning at this time for Tar Heel farmers in view of the summer drought conditions during the past three years. Clyde R. Greene, Chairman of the State Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee, believes...

He says, "The big problem this year is to produce all the feed we can, and at the same time, make our reserves go as far as they will by making good use of our pasture and hay land." This does not mean cutting down on livestock production through reduced feeding, but it does mean checking waste and using available feed efficiently, he added.

Greene points out that through improved pastures, a double saving may be realized. "Every pound of meat and quart of milk that can be produced from pasture is that much feed grain saved. In the face of increasing livestock numbers, and stepped-up feeding operations, there is need for making the best possible use of all sources of livestock feed." This, Greene says, is just a by-product of the basic reason for encouragement of improved pastures through the Agricultural Conservation Program.

Pasture improvement under the program serves to prevent soil erosion and to rebuild the soil for future production; however, the double-barreled benefit is still realized from pasture improvement. "This is just one more reason," Greene says, "why farmers should visit their County ASC Office when the sign-up for fall practices begins, and if needed, request assistance in carrying out one or more pasture improvement practices if they have need for this type of conservation."
