BUMPER HAY CROP

Based on condition reports from growers as of July 1, production from the 1955 hay crop in North Carolina is forecast at 1,111,000 tons from an estimated 1,099,000 acres for harvest. The above production, if realized, would be 2 per

cent above the short 1954 crop when 1,081,000 tons were produced from 1,180,000 acres. The all-hay yield of 1.01 tons per acre is about 5 per cent above last year and about equals the 10-year average of 1.02 tons per acre.

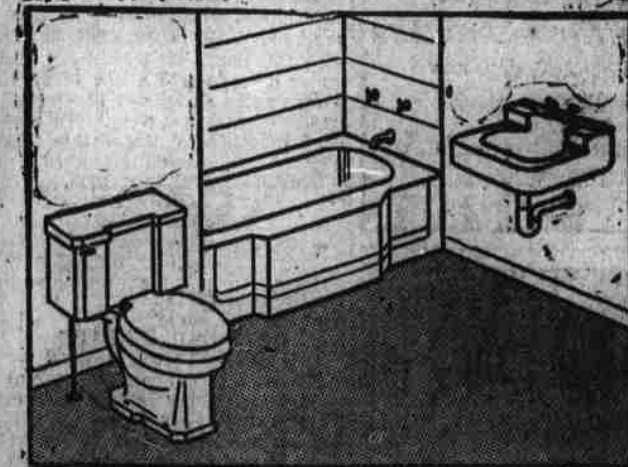
