At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Perquimans, North Carolina, held on Monday, October 13, 1958, at 10:00 o'clock, a. m., in the County Courthouse, the following business was transacted:

On motion duly made and passed, the Board authorized the installation of valves on radiators in Board of Education office.

On motion duly made and passed, the County Auditor was authorized to turn over the 1958 Tax Books and schedule "B" taxes to Sheriff J. K. White, for collection.

On motion duly made, seconded and passed, the Board accepted the settlement for 1957 taxes, submitted by Sheriff J. K. White, subject to final audit and approval by County Auditor and R. E. Aiken, Jr., C.P.A.

On motion duly made and passed, the Board appointed Mrs. Jack Kanoy, Delinquent Tax Collector for personal property for one year, required her bond to be \$1,000.00 and premium for same to be paid by the County.

On motion duly made, the Board authorized the purchase of law books for Perquimans County Court.

An Ordinance Pertaining to the Sanitation of the Town of Hertford, North Carolina, Relating to All Out-Door Privies, or Others, With No Sewer or Water Connection. After due discussion on the prevailing and existing unsanitary conditions now prevalent in parts of the Town of Hertford, due to outdoor or surface privies and toilets, and of the expected increase in population in the Town of Hertford, and for the betterment of good health in the said Town of Hertford, after due discussion the following ordinance, upon motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, it was resolved:

That on and after January 1, 1959, the following ordinance shall be in full force and effect: Definitions: (a) Dwelling - Any place of abode in which one or more persons live and reside. (b) Business - Any place where a business of any description is conducted, or carried on, is required under the Sanitary Laws of North Carolina, to have one or two toilets for its employees, or patrons.

That on and after January 1, 1959, it shall be unlawful for any property owner of property located in the Town of Hertford Town limits, that is located within one hundred (100) feet of the Town of Hertford's water and sewer system to have an outdoor, and/or pit privy or toilet, unless the same is connected with the Town of Hertford's water and sewer system.

That on and after January 1, 1959, it shall be unlawful for any tenant or renter or lessee, to rent a dwelling, or place of business where a toilet or toilets are required by the North Carolina Sanitary Law, to occupy the premises, unless the same is connected with the Town of Hertford's water and sewer system, provided the same is located within one hundred (100) feet of said water and sewer system.

That on and after January 1, 1959, each day that this ordinance is not complied with, shall be a violation of the same. That the violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine, or 30 days in jail, or both, in the discretion of the court.
