

**Patton's Bill**  
**Boat Sale Bill**  
 Owners of new unregistered boats who want to get their craft in the water immediately should look to the bill of sale.  
 Charles Patton, Executive Director of the N. C. Wildlife Resources Commission states that although it is Commission policy to allow new boat owners to use a bill of sale in lieu of a boat registration certificate and boat number, boat dealers sometimes fail to put enough information on the bill of sale to bring it within policy requirements.  
 Patton said that a bill of sale will be acceptable to wildlife inspectors in lieu of a certificate of registration for a period of thirty days if it meets these requirements: (1) full name and address of boat dealer; (2) full name and address of boat buyer; (3) make of boat; (4) length in feet; (5) year built; (6) hull material; (7) kind of propulsion; (8) date of purchase; (9) date of application for official certificate number, and (10) a statement subscribed to and sworn to by both dealer and buyer before a notary public that the information given in the bill of sale is true and accurate.  
 "The 1959 Boating Safety Act," Patton said, requires that all boats required to be registered must be registered and appropriate numbers displayed before it can be operated on the waters of the State.  
 "The provision for using a bill of sale in lieu of a registration certificate is a policy established by the Commission for the convenience of new boat owners, and boat dealers. A bill of sale, however, will not be honored unless it fulfills the requirements."

planted. There is a need for equipment that is adapted to such planting on our tight soils.  
 There are several advantages to building up the organic content of soils.  
 1. On sandy soils crop residues help control sand from blowing and increases the water holding capacity.  
 2. It helps hold open heavy soils so that they do not drain as readily in wet weather.  
 3. Organic matter on the surface has been shown to keep the soil temperature to ten degrees cooler in the root zone in hot weather than the root zone in same soil with no organic matter.  
 4. Organic matter improves the tilth of tight soils.  
 5. Organic matter also helps hold soil moisture by cutting down on evaporation from the surface.

 deposits totaled \$1,302,700 as of June 15th, not including government funds and inter-bank accounts.  
 If they had been included, together with savings accounts, the grand total on deposit in local banks would have been added up to \$2,887,200. It was \$2,826,000 in 1958.

**SOIL CONSERVATION NOTES**  
 During the month of June you will notice a lot of smoke rising in different areas of Perquimans County. You might wonder if it is a forest fire, but you will find that it is another field being burned after the small grain is harvested. This is discouraging to see since most of our soils need all the crop residue that it is possible to return to the soil in our crop rotations.  
 It is good to see fields of small grain which has fence grass or lespedeza seeded in them as these fields will not have to be cultivated after the grain is harvested. Where small grain is being followed by soybeans some farmers are baling the straw and preparing the land for planting the beans without burning the stubble which will supply some organic matter to the soil. Of course, much more organic matter would be added to the soil if all the straw was left on the land and the soybeans mulch

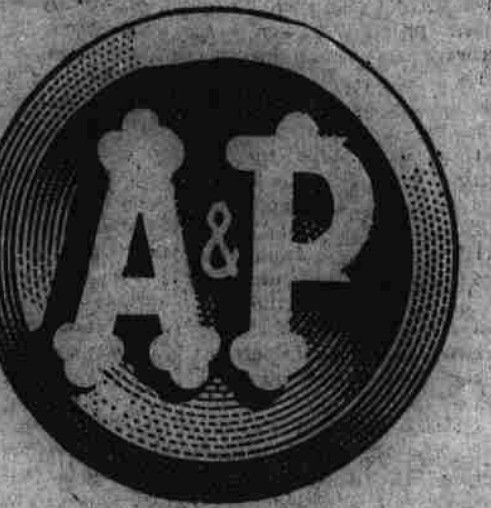
