

### KNOW YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY

Richard M. Myer, representative of the Social Security Administration, is in Hertford the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at Perquimans County Court House.

**Social Security Old-Age Insurance** payments at 65 are not new. The public has known of this type of benefit for years. Many, however, do not know the protection that the younger worker has while he or she is still on the job. These are the Survivor and Disability benefits.

Mr. Richard M. Myer, field representative of the Social Security Administration, said that after a worker has worked a year and a half and earned 6 quarters of coverage, his dependents could receive survivor social security payments if he died while still working. The worker might have needed 10 quarters of coverage for payments at 65, but only 6 are needed to give protection while still working. A lump-sum death payment could also be made.

### Buying On Credit Subject At Meeting

calf should be purchased in August to October, weighing from 400 to 650 pounds.

The steer should have clean water and feed all of the time. He should clean the feed trough at least twice a week so that feed won't get sour.

As time goes on you will have to break the steer to a halter and start preparing him for the show.
