

**OUTDOOR TIPS**

One easy way calls for hollowing out the inside of an uncut loaf of white bread. Cut it in two to hollow, then tape it back together. Next step is to open a hole in one end the size of a quarter. Now, park it in a likely spot overnight. Next morning, open up and pour the captured critters out.
