**The Power Of Weather**

Those who think that man's latest scientific inventions, including the most powerful nuclear bombs now existent, would be impressed with a recent group of statistics published by a weather expert. The statistics show that the power needed to lift the water which falls in a normal summer thunderstorm over an area of only a few miles, is of staggering proportions. The sun's rays fall upon the earth and heat the land. Because hot air rises, the warmed earth sends a thermal aloft and this warm air rises it is cooled. Every cloud is the result of some cooling. As the warm air rises it is cooled and forms a cloud. The moisture contained in the

air turns from invisible particles—condensation. **Sunday School Lesson**

**PRaise THE LORD!**  
International Sunday School Lesson for June 30, 1963.

Memory Selection: Let everything that breathes praise the Lord! Praise the Lord! (Psalms 150:6)

Lesson Text: Psalms 140; 147; 148.

In our lesson for today we try to help adults discover spiritual insights from the Psalms that show why men should praise the Lord.

As we have noted before, the Hebrew people were a singing people. Their hearts poured out in psalms of praise to the Lord. The three psalms comprising our Scripture lesson reveal why the psalms were and are so meaningful. Each of these expresses why men should praise the Lord. Psalms 150 praises His greatness; Psalms 147 lists the many ways in which God has shown His watchful care of Israel. And Psalms 148 suggests that we praise Him not only because of His greatness, His power, and His blessings to Israel, but also because of His steadfast love and concern for the imprisoned, the blind, and the hungry, the oppressed, and the righteous: "The Lord will reign for ever. Men's kingdoms come and go. The kingdom of God, who is ever concerned with those in need, is an eternal Kingdom.

The psalmist is speaking against that faith in man which makes faith in God either secondary or unimportant. When our loyalty to God becomes subservient to our loyalty to man, the real danger has come. Faith in other men is essential. It is equally essential that we be trustworthy even as we would have others be worthy of trust, for one small act of deceit destroys the entire climate of faith. The psalmist informs us that to put our complete faith in men is to trust that which is transient, passing. Man is not worthy of our absolute trust because every man will die; and with his last breath his best plans come to an end. The conclusion of the psalmist is that we must place our primary hope, above and beyond all else, in God himself—for he alone does not die. He alone is eternal. He alone has time and power to fulfill the plans he has made.

When two people have faith in each other, it does not mean that each has accepted a list of propositions drawn up about the other. Nor does it mean that they have accepted what another has said to be true. Faith is the act of trusting in which two people commit themselves to each other and trust each other to fulfill the commitment. This is what the psalmist meant when he called men to praise the Lord and to trust Him rather than other men. We are to commit ourselves to God, enter into a living relationship with Him, trust His faithfulness, reveal ourselves consciously to Him, and discover His self-revelation in return.

Every man must commit his life to something that gives it meaning. If there are those among us whose lives seem meaningless to them, then they have committed themselves to such meaninglessness. They could find meaning in God; they refuse to. They could find meaning and purpose through the church; they refuse to.

Man's spirit is never fully satisfied until he has made the commitment of self to God. God gives eternal meaning to life. When we are committed to God, the entire world, though it is the same, becomes different for us. Every choice takes on new meaning. Every undertaking is filled with new joy.

The world is filled with people, fine people—for every person is a child of God. Every person is an opportunity for friendship. Every person is a challenge to express the love of Christ. Brotherhood is no longer just a word; it is a reality. Our concern for the hungry, the poverty-stricken, the jobless, must now find an outlet.

Before commitment we need only to talk about such things. Since commitment, we must do something for our spirits are in communion with Him whose spirit is ever ready in the presence of human want.

For the whole world is filled with people who are hungry for God. We have found a new meaning in our lives. We are committed to a life of service, of love, and of peace.
