### ASCS News

**1964 Feed Grain Program**  
The 1964 feed grain program is very similar to the 1963 program. The program will be voluntary, all feed grain bases are combined, diversion payments are available, and price support will be made available to participating farms.

There are a few basic changes that affect farmers. Farmers may divert the large of 25 acres or 50% of the feed grain bases. This compares with a maximum divert the larger of 25 acres or acres or 40% of the base in 1963. The payment rates will be higher this year for farmers diverting above 40% of their total base. The double cropping provision will be eliminated from the 1964 program. Acreage diverted in 1964 may not have a crop harvested under the double cropping provision.

The 1964 program sign-up will be held, some time early in 1964. Each individual farmer will be notified of his base and payment rate prior to sign-up time. Further information about the details of the program will be available at sign-up time. Farmers desiring additional information at this time should contact their local ASCS office.

**Reconstitutions Of Farms**  
Farmers who buy or sell farmland in Perquimans County should notify the ASCS Office of these transactions. This information is most important to us in keeping your farm ownership and operator records current and accurate.

Farmers that have been given approval for Federal cost-share for ACP practices should report the extent of performance as soon as the practice is completed. Peanut cards should be returned to the ASCS office upon completion of sales. The number of pounds of peanuts on hand for seed should be entered and the farmer's signature in the appropriate spaces.
