Continued from Page 1 history, McCallum found no single book devoted to various aspects of the subject. He decided to write one, with an assist from his wife, a University of Texas English major.

For years the McCallum spent vacations and most spare moments gathering information for the book. Their home became the nation's clearing house for ideas and bits of information concerning barbed wire and its impact on the history of the United States.

As the collection grew, so did the information on barbed wire. Six years went by; then the book was published.

It is divided into three major parts. The first is the story of those who invented and manufactured barbed wire. The second part tells some of the stories of the West where barbed wire was not accepted without range war, fence cutting and other violence. A third section contains descriptions and drawings of 36 different types of barbed wire — for those who would like to build a collection of their own.
