spring of 1963. This included the purchase of tires referred to, as well as payment for the surplus bus. This bus was never moved from the school garage premises until all financial obligations were cleared. Due to inability to secure license for the bus, it was not moved until the first week in May, 1963. Actually, as I interpret the auditor's report, the county has been overpaid in the amount of \$28.11 with respect to the purchase of the surplus bus and other indicated items.

Over the past two years the matters referred to in Exhibit "C" have been thoroughly explained to the Perquimans County Board of Education. With knowledge of these matters, the board renewed my contract as superintendent for a two year period, beginning July 1, 1965. I have done my best to work in harmony with this board. Certainly, complete harmony prevailed with respect to all past boards. I have no malice or ill will against any member of the present County Board of Education. I am ready to work with them for the betterment of our schools. After all is said and done, this should not be a clash between personalities for we must all work in the best interest of our school children.
