Hertford Police Busy In May

Hertford's Police Department had a right busy month during May, according to a report made to the Town Board Monday night by Police Captain B. L. Gibbs.

According to Officer Gibbs, a total of 14 persons were arrested and of the total 12 were found guilty as charged.

The arrests and charges were three drunks, three assaults, two careless and reckless driving, three miscellaneous traffic arrests, one miscellaneous arrest, two breaking and entering. Fines amounted to \$295 and the court costs \$150, totaling \$445.

The department answered and investigated 105 calls, investigated two accidents, worked four funerals, extended 112 courties, found two doors unlocked, answered four fire calls, 216 radio calls, reported three lights out and recovered three stolen bicycles.

 The price support loan rate for 1967 crop wheat is \$1.28 per bushel. Loans are available on grain stored in acceptable farm facilities or in Commodity Credit Corporation approved warehouses. Loans bear interest at the rate of 30c per each whole unit of \$100.00 per month. A service of \$4.00 per loan is also charged.

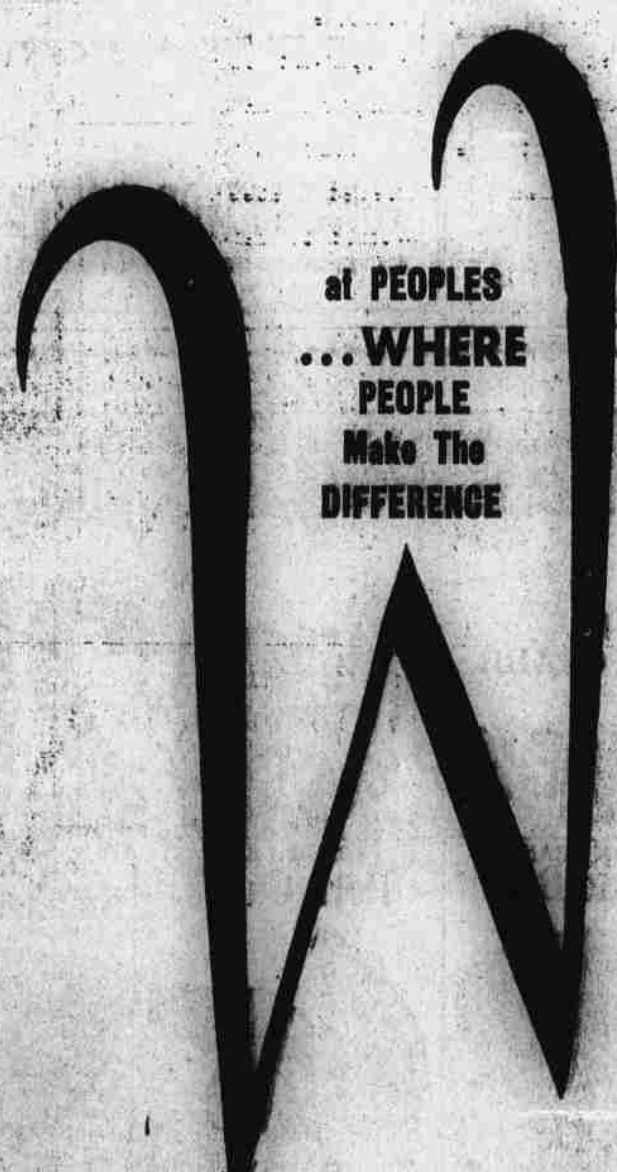
