

'The Lost Colony' Gets Ready For 31st Season

Thirty years ago — on July 4, 1937 — the first performance of "The Lost Colony" was presented in the Waterside Theater on the Fort Raleigh National Historic Site near this Roanoke Island community. Except for a one-year "blackout" during World War II, the play has been presented every summer, making it the "granddaddy" of outdoor, symphonic dramas bringing history alive.

This, when "The Lost Colony" opens for 1967 on June 23, it will mark the 27th production season. Performances will continue at 8:45 P. M. (Eastern Daylight Saving Time) through August 27, Monday through Saturday of each week, with closing night the only Sunday performance of the season.

"The Lost Colony" was written by Pulitzer Prize-winner Paul Green and directed and choreographed by Joe Layton of Broadway, TV and Hollywood fame. Layton won an EMMY award for staging the Barbara Streisand TV spectacular and a TONY award for directing and choreographing Richard

Rodgers' "No Strings" on Broadway. He recently choreographed a motion picture, "Thoroughly Modern Millie", starring Julie Andrews, Carol Channing and Mary Tyler Moore.

A company of 135 performers and technicians stages "The Lost Colony" to tell the story of Sir Walter Raleigh's first English settlements in America in the 1580's — 30 years before Jamestown and 30 years before Plymouth Rock. Also depicted is the birth of Virginia Dare, first child of English parents born in what is now the United States.

Site of Fort Raleigh and the 2,000-seat Waterside Theater is on North Carolina's famed Dare Coast — Outer Banks. Nearby are the Atlantic beach resorts of Kitty Hawk, Kill Devil Hills, Nags Head, Hatteras and Ocracoke. It was at Kitty Hawk and Kill Devil Hills where the Wright Brothers first flew in 1903.

The Dare Coast - Outer Banks is 90 miles south of Norfolk, Va., 136 miles east of Interstate 95 and U. S. 301 highways, and 67 miles southeast of U. S. 17, the Ocean Highway.
