## Wendell E. Smith Named Asst. To Pres. Colonial Stores

He was a distinguished military graduate at Michigan State and served as an interceptor pilot in the U. S. Air Force. He is 35 years old.

As president of the 300,000-member United States Jaycee organization, Mr. Smith traveled thousands of miles in the United States and abroad in an effort to bring greater understanding of the necessity of relieving the plight of underprivileged people.
