

Eliz. City Fire Co. Sponsoring Circus April 13th

One of the biggest and most thrilling events for children of all ages from four to eighty-four takes place in Elizabeth City on Monday, April 13. The Famous Circus Bartok,

will present performances at Elizabeth City sponsored by Volunteer Fire Company #1, Elizabeth City. It's all under the big top on the showgrounds at National Guard Grounds.

The first mammoth fleet of rainbow-hued motorized circus units will arrive on the showgrounds about three in the morning and they will continue to arrive in sections until noon. Activity will begin at daylight when the lot superintendent and surveyors start laying out the grounds for the vast canvas city. Elephants will be working erecting the big center poles and the heavy canvas, moving cages and at various other chores that only the big elephant power can handle.

The public is invited to come out and watch the bigtop go up. How this precision operation of erecting an auditorium which seats more than 3,000 persons in such a short time, only experienced circus people seem to know.

The big circus sideshow, concession, refreshment and the novelty stands will open as soon as they are set up and ready to serve. Doors to the main circus will open one hour before the main show starting times.

The brilliant two-hour performance of the Famous Circus Bartok lives up to the billing, "The Show That's Different", presenting the most diversified array of performing animals of any show now under canvas. It features the Naganos and their performing crocodiles from Pakistan, the land of the Punjab mystics; Jan Perz and his mammoth Russian motor-cycle riding bears; The Soto free flying doves and giant golden eagle from Perus, S. A.; an amazing big group of performing goats from Siam; a large group of military ponies and, of course, two herds of performing elephants of all sizes from giants to babies.

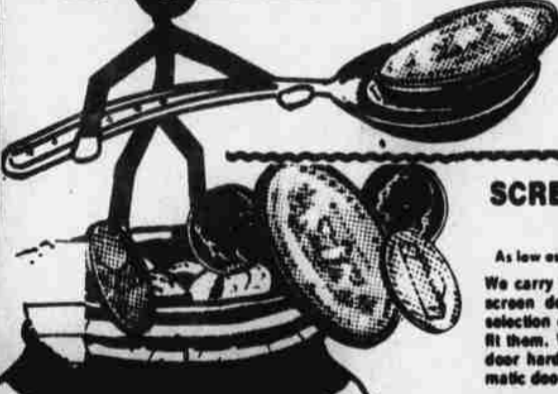
