





LESSON TEST: Isaiah 1:16-17; Matthew 5:21-44; I John 3:11-24.

In our personal commitment to the Christian faith we are ever constrained to live that faith in all of life's relationships. And perhaps one of the most demanding (and the most rewarding) facets of Christianity is concern for others.

Concern for all men was the ever-present factor in Christ's life on earth, and He was the embodiment of God's concern for all mankind. Concern was the keynote of all His teachings.
