Tax Payer Filing Errors Show Decrease

GREENSBORO - On February 26, 1970, North Carolina taxpayers had filed 305,000 individual federal tax returns and had made a total of 18,583 errors. On that same date in 1971, Tar Heels had filed 340,000 returns but had made only 8,248 filing errors - a vast improvement.
