Bond Sales Reach Halfway Mark Of County's Quota

Series E United States Savings Bonds during May amounted to \$8,457,397, an increase of more than 14 per cent over sales in May of last year. Combined sales of both Series E and H Bonds for May were \$8,811,807, a 12.3 per cent increase over last year's E, H, and Freedom Share sales.

January-May cumulative sales amounted to \$31,889,827, the largest volume sold for any comparable period since 1945, and a 12 per cent increase over 1970 sales for the same period. This represents 49.8 per cent of the state's 1971 dollar goal of \$63,600,000.

Sales in Perquimans County during May were \$4,300. January-May sales totaled \$33,701. This represents 50.5 per cent of the county's goal of \$66,780, according to R.L. Stevenson, County Volunteer Chairman.
