## WEEKLY RECIPE

Sarah Anne Sheridan

There're days in every homemaker's schedule that leave little time to prepare a meal of several dishes. This is a nourishing and attractive one dish dinner.

### One Dish Dinner

- 3 or 4 onions sliced
- 3 lbs. ground lean beef
- 1 can mushroom soup
- 1 can whole corn
- 1 c diced celery
- 1 green pepper diced
- 1 c noodles
- 1 can condensed tomato soup
- 3 T crisco
- grated cheese
- salt and pepper

In a large skillet lightly brown onions in the crisco. Add ground beef and continue stirring until beef turns dark and is separated. Add mushroom soup, corn, celery and green pepper. Stir often and add a little water if necessary. Cover and simmer until done. Cook noodles in salted boiling water. Add to beef mixture and season. Pour into casserole, cover with condensed tomato soup and cover lightly with grated cheese. Return to oven long enough for mixture to bubble. The meal is complete with a salad and bread.
