828 Perquimans

People On Donated Foods Program

There were 828 low-income Perquimans County people on the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Donated Foods program in October as compared to 811 in September, Russell H. James, Southeast regional administrator of USDA's Food and Nutrition Service, reports.

Taking North Carolina as a whole, James noted, there was a small increase on the number of people receiving assistance during the month. In October 284,992 were given assistance—an increase of 5,956 over September's total.

Most of the increase, he said, was in the food stamp program now operating in 51 North Carolina counties. During the month, 168,578 people were issued over \$4 million in food coupons. Of this amount, more than \$2.7 million was in the form of free bonus stamps.

Machinery Act of 1971. G. S. 105-308. Duty to list; penalty for failure.

Every person in whose name any property is to be listed under the terms of this subchapter shall list the property with the tax supervisor or proper list taker within the time allowed by law on an abstract setting forth the information required by this subchapter.

In addition to all other penalties prescribed by law, any person whose duty it is to list any property who willfully fails or refuses to list the same within the time prescribed by law shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment not to exceed six months. The failure to list shall be prima facie evidence that the failure was willful.

Any person who removes or conceals property for the purpose of evading taxation or who aids or abets the removal or concealment of property for the purpose of evading taxation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment not to exceed six months.
