**This Is The Law**

What, in general, is meant by the exemption laws of debtors? All states have statutes known as exemption laws, which provide that, no matter how just a debt may be that is due, certain property may not be levied upon and sold to satisfy a judgment. These laws differ greatly in the several states. Many of these statutes go into much detail, naming in many instances a long list, mainly household articles, which are exempt.

The eastern state are far less liberal than the western states. In California for example, the head of a family is allowed a homestead exemption of not exceeding \$5,000 in addition to a long list of personal articles.

In North Carolina there are two types of exemptions, both provide for in the Constitution of North Carolina: personal property exemptions and homestead exemptions. In this State a debtor may assert free from the claims of his creditors any of his personal property up to the value of five hundred dollars and a homestead of not exceeding one thousand dollars in real estate.

These exemption laws are designed to prevent a grasping creditor from taking all of the property of his debtor so that the debtor and the debtor's family are not left destitute, without clothing and furniture, tools necessary to earn a livelihood, or the means to make a new financial start in life-in short in a position where they must become public charges. The public interest is made by law superior to the private claim of a private creditor.

If the judgment debtor has neither real nor personal property out of which a judgment can be satisfied, the securing of a judgment in a court action may be a barren victory. One cannot get blood out of a turnip. There can be no imprisonment for ordinary debts.

How does a debtor assert his personal property exemption? Unlike the homestead exemption, the debtor is not entitled to a \$500 personal property exemption unless he or his attorney makes a demand that the exemption be set apart to him.  
After a judgment has been obtained in a legal action, the sheriff or other officer will levy upon the property of the debtor. It is at this point, or at any time before the sale of the property or the appropriation of it by the court to satisfy the judgment that the debtor or his attorney demands the exemption.

Who makes the appraisal for personal property and homestead exemptions? The sheriff or other officer making the levy summons three appraisers.  
The debtor has a right to select the articles to be appraised and laid off as his property exemption.

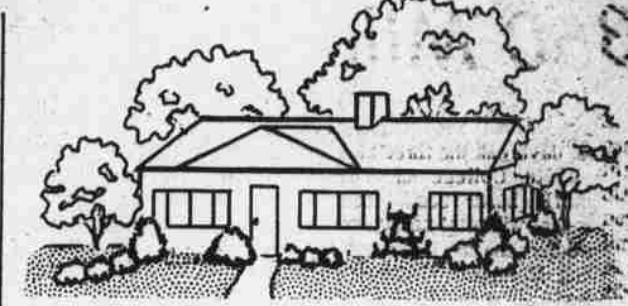
**Landscape Fashions Change**

**Make Plans Before Planting Trees**

Tree planting around a home is a long-term "investment" that can add greatly to the beauty and comfort of a home -- provided that the selection and location of the trees are well thought out.

Years ago, it was the landscape fashion to have two large "twin" trees on either side of the front walk, flanking the entranceway. But things have changed. Today, the trend is toward a natural grouping that will eventually give the appearance that the trees were planted by nature.

North Carolina State University horticulturists suggest that, in most cases, two trees are needed to frame a house. This is true if the property is large and the house is set far back from the street or highway, as is often found at the farm home.  
The smaller the



house, the smaller the trees you should plant, the NCSU specialists suggest. Consider using one large tree on one side and a cluster of small-growing trees on the opposite side. This gives a natural unbalanced appearance, especially desirable for homes of informal architecture. However, even homes of formal design can make use of this principle.

In addition to foreground framing, trees are needed back of the house to frame the roof-

line to give the roof something to "rest against."  
An important use of shade trees is to cast shadows on the house during the heat of the summer. Even the air-conditioned home will benefit, since shadows on the roof on a hot day will help reduce need for air-conditioning.

If you need a large-growing shade tree for this purpose, determine its location with a long pole the same length as the ultimate height of the tree.

**To Cut Heating Bill Don't Heat Outdoors**

**RALEIGH --** The best way to cut your home heating bill -- or keep it at its lowest possible point -- is to avoid heating the outdoors.

Warm air rises and expands, and if there are ways for it to get out of your house it will. So here are some tips from Charlotte Womble, extension housing specialist, North Carolina State University, that may help you keep warm air in the house.

First, insulate. Insulation is a relatively inexpensive material and a properly insulated home has little heat loss. Place 4 to 6 inches of insulation between the ceiling joists in the attic. Fill spaces between walls. Also put insulation between floor joists under all rooms that cover unheated areas such as crawl spaces. Also use storm win-

dows and storm doors. You can substitute clear vinyl or plastic sheetings if you wish, Miss Womble points out. Secure sheeting to outside window trims with strips of screen molding. Keep door closed. It's a good idea to install self-closing fasteners on storm doors so they won't stand open, the specialist observes.

Let air circulate. If you have forced-air heating, make sure the cold air return outlet is not blocked by furniture, rugs or other objects. Use a fan to push warm air to hard-to-heat areas of the home.

Close fireplace dampers when fireplace is not in use. If the fireplace is never used, close it off with insulating board. This will reduce the movement of heated air out of the chimney.
