NEW PATTERN
Do you have a favorite pattern that you've used so much it's worn out? Or do you mix parts of different patterns to create your own fashions? If so, you can make a like-new pattern from the old by using a strong, but lightweight, woven tissue that is sheer enough to see through. Plan Vegetable Garden On Paper

It's time to plan your 1973 vegetable garden if you haven't already. You will be better satisfied with your garden if it is planned before the first seeds are put into the ground.

George Hughes, North Carolina State University extension horticulture specialist, emphasizes that the plan may not be very meaningful unless it is written down.

He suggests that you show the location of each crop and the amount to

be planted. On an average, about one-fourth acre per person should be sufficient. However, take into consideration your intentions to freeze or can, and plant accordingly.

If possible, the garden site should be rotated from year to year to help


