Party Guests Insured

"Let's have a party!" Sounds good almost any time of the year. The approach of warm weather in North Carolina makes the idea particularly attractive—the chance to get out and see people—have friends over for dinner—birthday parties for the kids.

But what about your legal responsibility to guests in your home? The Insurance Information Institute reports that most exposures to liability that may result from a guest being injured on your property are covered by your homeowners insurance policy.

Indoor parties on newly-waxed floors and backyard get-togethers in the half-light of dusk may offer hazards not present when only the family is at home. Swarms of adults and running kids are more prone to slip and falls in unfamiliar surroundings.

And if you own of the nation's 65 million cats and dogs, it is not difficult to imagine a guest being nipped or scratched by a pet overbrought by excitement. The point is, reminds the Institute, if a guest is injured in your home and you are found responsible, you may be required to make him "whole" again—that is pay for his injuries, replace any lost income, and compensate him for his pain and suffering.

The homeowners policy—also purchased by persons renting apartments—provides insurance protection for the homeowner or tenant who is found legally liable for a person's injuries or

damage to his property. In addition to paying damage awards up to the limits provided in a policy (usually \$25,000), the policy provides the home owner's legal defenses if he is sued. Also, the policy pays an injured person's medical bills, usually up to \$500 or \$1,000, regardless of who was at fault for the injury.

The Institute notes that homeowners and tenants policies do not provide coverage for claims arising from a party conducted solely for business reasons.
