Artistic Courses

College of the Albemarle is offering courses in pottery and drawing and painting through its Adult Education Division.

Registration for the pottery course is open through Oct. 15. Classes are held each Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the COA Art Center on Riverside Avenue. The course ends Dec. 17.

Basic instruction of the course will be the use of the potter's wheel, preparation of clay and blazng procedures. Instruction will be received in the use of the new gas fire kiln for reduction and oxidation firings. The course is for beginners as well as advanced students.

Registration for the drawing and painting course is open through Oct. 17. The course ends Dec. 19. Classes will meet each Thursday from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at COA's Art Center. This course is also for beginners as well as advanced students. No previous experience is necessary.

Basic drawing and painting principles will be taught and instruction in the use of oils and acrylics. Instructor for both courses is Ben Hill who has been associated with the Art Education Department of COA for seven years. Hill received a Bachelor of Science degree in ceramics and art education from East Carolina University at Greenville where he has done graduate work in ceramics. The instructor has attended courses at the Corcoran School of Art in Washington, D.C.
