 Coffee." He presented the

 stated that a coffee tree  
 produces only one pound of  
 coffee a year for produces 35  
 years. He added that coffee  
 is not harmful even for  
 children and that it is non-  
 addicting. Tulloh said a soft  
 drink has more harmful

ingredients that coffee and  
 that drip coffee yields a  
 better taste than any other  
 coffee making method. He  
 gave several recipes using  
 coffee and following his talk,  
 there was a question and  
 answer period.

Mrs. Modlin thanked the  
 guest speaker and presented  
 him a gift from the  
 homemakers.
