Government Commission has
notified the Board that the
application has been filed and
accepted for submission to the
Local Government Finance
Commission. NOW,
THEREFORE,
BE IT ORDERED by the
Board of Commissioners of the
County of Perquimans as
follows:
Section 1. The Board of
Commissioners of the County of
Perquimans has ascertained
and hereby determines that it is
necessary to acquire and
construct a system for the
supply, storage, treatment and
distribution of water, including
the construction of water wells,
water supply lines, storage
tanks and a treatment plant and
the acquisition of existing
facilities serving the Woodville
section of the County of
Perquimans and a small
portion of the adjoining County
of Pasquotank, and the
acquisition and installation of
the equipment and machinery
required therefor and the
acquisition of the necessary
land or rights-in-land, and to
pay the capital costs of such

improvements.
Section 2. In order to raise the
money required to pay the
capital costs of the
improvements as set forth
above, in addition to any funds
which may be available for
such purpose from any other
source, bonds of the County of
Perquimans are hereby
authorized and shall be issued
pursuant to The Local
Government Finance Act of
North Carolina. The Maximum
aggregate principal amount of
said bonds authorized by this
bond order shall be \$2,350,000.
Section 3. A tax sufficient to
pay the principal of and interest
on said bonds when due shall be
annually levied and collected.
The revenues of the system
hereinbefore described may be
pledged to the payment of the
interest on and principal of said
bonds if and to the extent that
the Board of Commissioners
shall hereafter determine by
resolution prior to the issuance
of said bonds. In such event, the
tax to pay the principal of and
interest on said bonds may be
reduced by the amount of such
revenues available for the
payment of such principal and
interest.

Section 4. A sworn statement
of the County's debt has been
filed with the Clerk of the Board
of Commissioners and is open to
public inspection.
Section 5. This bond order
shall take effect when approved
by the voters of the County of
Perquimans at a referendum.
The foregoing bond order has
been introduced and a sworn
statement of debt has been filed
under the Local Government
Bond Act showing the appraised
value of the County of
Perquimans to be \$44,877,787
and the net debt thereof,
including the proposed bonds, to
be \$106,900. A tax will be levied
to pay the principal of and
interest on the bonds if they are
issued. Anyone who wishes to be
heard on the questions of the
validity of the bond order and
the advisability of issuing the
bonds may appear at a public
hearing or an adjournment
thereof to be held at Board
Room, Perquimans County
Courthouse, in Hertford, North
Carolina, at 8:00 o'clock, P.M.,
on the 20th day of October, 1975.


