NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held in the County of Perquimans, North Carolina, on December 6, 1975, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said County the question whether they shall approve or disapprove, (1) the indebtedness to be incurred by the issuance of bonds of said County of the maximum principal amount of \$2,350,000, which indebtedness shall be secured by a pledge of the County's faith and credit, and (2) the levy of a tax for the payment of such bonds and (3) the bond order entitled "Bond Order authorizing the issuance of \$2,350,000 Water Bonds of the County of Perquimans", adopted by the Board of Commissioners on October 20, 1975, to authorize the issuance of said bonds and the levy of

such tax. The Water Bonds are authorized to finance the capital costs of acquiring and constructing a system for the supply, storage, treatment and distribution of water, including the construction of water wells, water supply lines, storage tanks and a treatment plant and the acquisition of existing facilities serving the Woodville section of the County of Perquimans and a small portion of the adjoining County of Pasquotank, and the acquisition and installation of the equipment and machinery required therefor and the acquisition of the necessary land or rights-in-land, and a tax to be levied for the payment thereof be approved? with squares labeled "Yes" and "No" beneath or beside such words in which squares the voter may record his choice. In the event a majority of qualified voters voting at said election vote to approve such order, the incurring of such indebtedness and the levy of such tax, said bonds shall be issued and a tax shall be levied for the payment of such bonds.

Wards BP Station, Belhel; Perquimans County Courthouse, Hertford-East; Perquimans County Health Department, Hertford-West; New Hope Community Building, New Hope; Wintall Community Building, Parksville; Belvidere Community Building, Belvidere; Whiteston Community Building, Nicanor.  
The registration records will be kept open at the office of the Perquimans County Board of Elections, County Agricultural Building, 104 Dobb Street, Hertford, North Carolina, from 9:00 o'clock, A.M., until 1:00 o'clock, P.M., on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays through November 7, 1975, and at the homes of the respective Registrars and Judges of

election for the above Precincts, by appointment, through November 7, 1975. The last day for registration for the election will be November 7, 1975.  
Any qualified voter of the County who expects to be absent from the County during all of said election day or who, because of sickness or other physical disability will be unable to be present at the polls to vote in person on said day, may apply for an absentee ballot to be used in voting at said election not earlier than thirty days prior to said election and not later than 5:00 o'clock, P.M., on December 3, 1975.
